This song is based on a three beat in a bar pattern. It may also be useful to ask children if they think the Abbey would have had bells? Find the audio file here:

The steps are:

- 1. Sing the song teachers turn pupils turn
- 2. Pupils sing and keep the beat in by clapping (beat one) and then clicking so clap, click click.
- 3. In a circle whilst singing one pupil claps (alone) the next two click alone
- 4. Try and varying speeds how fast can they go?

Game:

- 1. Stand in a circle
- 2. One person walks around the circle carrying a small token/toy.
- 3. They drop it behind the person they are closest to at the end of the song and run around the circle to take the person's place.
- 4. The other person picks up the toy and chases them and become the next 'on it' person.
