
Play the game and Learn about weather and climate

#### Before you start:

- Print the board (for best result print on A3 card).
- Print and cut out the Question Cards.
- Print, cut out and fold the Answer Cards
- Find a token for each of the people playing.
- Find a dice.
- Read the rules of the game and have fun!
- Shuffle the Question Cards and place the deck of cards face down on the side of the board






#### Rules of the Game:

- Roll the dice: move forward on the board of as many steps as the number on the dice.
- If the box where you land has an instruction on it (move forward one box; move back one box; etc) follow the instruction!
- If the box where you land has a picture, you will have to choose one of the Question Cards and answer the question on it (each Question Card has a number: one of the other players will have to check the answer on corresponding Answer Card)
- If your answer is right you can advance 1 box
- If your answer is wrong you will go back 2 boxes.
- Continue like this in turns: the person who gets to the end first wins!


